Urine Drug Screen (Level 1)



Cost: There is an out of pocket fee for this test unless a third party has been nominated. If you nominate a third party to pay, you must provide QML with a written statement (on letter-headed paper) from the third party clearly stating they will incur the costs. Without payment the collection will not proceed.

What to expect

- Formal ID must be shown to the collector or no collection.
- The collector will be in front or next to you while you urinate.
- You will need to sign all labels, seals and forms.
 Please follow collectors' instructions on where to sign.
- Forms asking about your current medications and other personal information will be given to you to fill in. You must complete any forms presented to you.
- You will need to be in the presence of the collector until the last sample is sealed in a tamper proof bag.
 Please be patient and wait until the collector instructs you to leave.

Sample Collection - General Steps

- 1. The collector will ask you to take off any unneeded outer clothes (e.g. coat) and empty pockets.
- 2. All personal belongings will be left outside the collection room.
- 3. You will be asked to wash your hands infront of the collector.
- A coloured solution will be added to the toilet. Water taps and soap will be made tamper evident (i.e. a paper bag taped over the taps).
- 5. A sample collection cup will be given and you need to submit a minimum 35 mL of urine. A collection staff member will stand in front of you (female) or closely beside you (male) to watch you urinating.
- 6. Once finished, hand the specimen container to the collector before you flush.
- 7. The urine will be temperature tested. If the temperature is outside 33-38 °C, or anything unusual is noted of the specimen, another sample will be taken.



Staff and patients need to work and be cared for in a safe environment. Violence and verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
